i reject fear as a teaching tool; courage and care build better dancers. i believe honesty is a form of **respect** and respect high standards. no to means cages; it takes a village to starve an artist, i want schools to be tough, safe, and transformative. i want dancers who are strong, curious, and free. humor belongs in the studio; laughter is part of the training. the public is not stupid. i want audiences to rise with us, not watch from over there, i insist on dancing fully; we are not baking cookie-cutter dancers. dance stop using as a garnishment. dance is infrastructure and deserves real support. i choose collaboration the dance over competition. world is small enough to be kind.
