

PreCollege Music at Zurich University of the Arts

General terms and conditions

1. Objective and scope of application

These general terms and conditions (GTC) state the basic provisions for participation in the PreCollege Music programme at Zurich University of the Arts (ZHdK). They apply to young students on the PreCollege Music programme.

2. Application, admission and acceptance of training place

The written application is legally binding.

To be admitted to PreCollege Music, candidates must pass an entrance exam and accept a training place.

By confirming the training place in the PreCollege Music, the undersigned declares that he/she has acknowledged and accepted these General terms and conditions as well as the "Regulations of the PreCollege Music".

3. Duration

The PreCollege Music programme runs for two semesters and two semester instalments are billed. Upon admission to PreCollege Music, the young students undertake to settle both semester invoices. Withdrawal from PreCollege Music during the course of an academic year or a waiver of the second semester fee is not possible.

4. Semester fees and payment terms

The following semester fees apply:

For students with legal residency status in the canton of Zurich:

External major 1,150.00

Internal major 1,950.00

For students with legal residency status outside the canton of Zurich:

External major 1,400.00

Internal major 2,200.00

The semester fees are to be paid in accordance with the invoice before the start of the semester.

5. Withdrawal and cancellation

Notifications of withdrawal must be made in writing.

In the case of withdrawals after the signed confirmation of the training place, the full course costs of two semester fees will be payable.

6. Interruption

The PreCollege Music programme cannot be interrupted.

7. Insurance and liability

The young students of PreCollege Music are responsible for their own insurance. ZHdK does not accept any liability for damage or losses.

8. Applicable law and place of jurisdiction

Swiss law shall apply exclusively. The place of jurisdiction is Zurich.
